

**Deadline to Respond
to the Proposed Deletion of Non-eligible Substances
from the Domestic Substances List is May 8th, 2007**

The proposal is to remove around 1,100 substances that were mis-nominated to the DSL and include at least one commonly used chemical: Bitrex (CAS# 3734-33-6). Most of these substances have been listed on the DSL since it was first published in 1994 and we recommend you review the list to determine if your business may be impacted. If a substance you are using is de-listed you will be required to file New Substances Notification to continue manufacturing or importing the substance.
