**Technical Amendments to the
Consumer Chemicals and Containers Regulations, 2001

Health Canada is now proceeding with the steps required to obtain approval by the Governor in Council to pre-publish the technical amendments to the CCCR-2001 in *Canada Gazette, Part I*. The modifications clarify certain requirements and correct a number of editorial errors, to ensure that the original intent of the Regulations is maintained.
